The NYLIM Candriam U.S. Large Cap Equity ETF tracks an index that is designed to deliver exposure to U.S. large- and medium-cap equity securities of companies that satisfy environmental, social and corporate governance (ESG) criteria developed by Candriam.

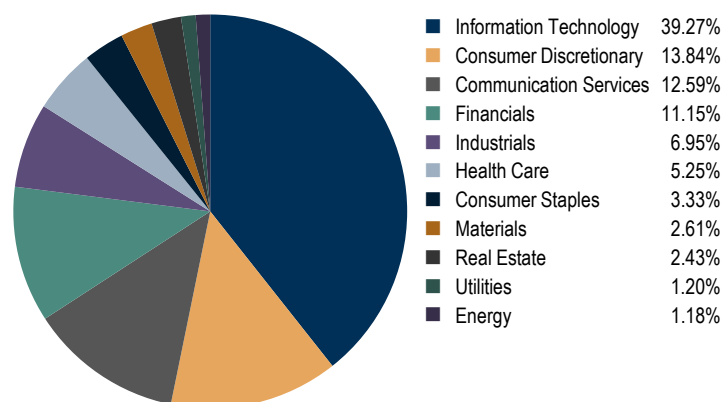

The NYLIM Candriam U.S. Large Cap Equity Index (the Underlying Index) is a broad-based, market-cap weighted index that consists of the top-scoring U.S. large-cap companies meeting environmental, social and corporate governance (ESG) criteria developed by Candriam and weighted using a market capitalization weighting methodology. Candriam's scores favor innovative companies, with high quality operations and exposure to structural trends. The Underlying Index was developed by New York Life Investment Management, LLC ("NYLIM") with Candriam acting as index consultant. Candriam is a wholly owned subsidiary of New York Life Investment Management Holdings, LLC.

The S&P 500[®] Index is widely regarded as the standard index for measuring large-cap U.S. stock market performance. The S&P 500 Index is generally representative of the market sectors or types of investments in which the Fund invests.

The Morningstar Medalist Rating[™] is the summary expression of Morningstar's forward-looking analysis of investment strategies as offered via specific vehicles using a rating scale of Gold, Silver, Bronze, Neutral, and Negative. The Medalist Ratings indicate which investments Morningstar believes are likely to outperform a relevant index or peer group average on a risk-adjusted basis over time. Investment products are evaluated on three key pillars (People, Parent, and Process) which, when coupled with a fee assessment, forms the basis for Morningstar's conviction in those products' investment merits and determines the Medalist Rating they're assigned. Pillar ratings take the form of Low, Below Average, Average, Above Average, and High. Pillars may be evaluated via an analyst's qualitative assessment (either directly to a vehicle the analyst covers or indirectly when the pillar ratings of a covered vehicle are mapped to a related uncovered vehicle) or using algorithmic techniques. Vehicles are sorted by their expected performance into rating groups defined by their Morningstar Category and their active or passive status.
