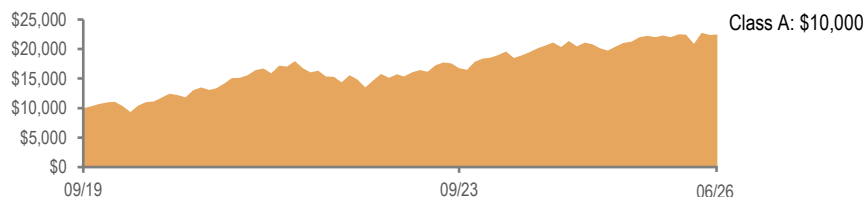

## Before You Invest

**Before considering an investment in the Fund, you should understand that you could lose money.**

All investments are subject to market risk, including possible loss of principal. The Fund is non-diversified, which means that it may invest a greater amount of its assets in the securities of a single issuer or a small number of issuers than a diversified fund. Having a larger percentage of assets in a smaller number of issuers makes a non-diversified fund more susceptible to the risk that one single event or occurrence can have a significant adverse impact upon the Fund. The investment strategies, practices and risk analyses used by the Subadvisor may not produce the desired results or expected returns. The investments selected by the Subadvisor may underperform the market in which the Fund invests or other investments.

**1. Average annual total returns** include the change in share price and reinvestment of dividends and capital gain distributions. Class I shares are generally only available to corporate and institutional investors. Class R shares are available only through corporate-sponsored retirement plans. Effective August 25, 2023, the Fiera Capital U.S. Equity Long-Term Quality Fund (the "Predecessor Fund") was reorganized into the MainStay PineStone U.S. Equity Fund (the Fund). As accounting successor to the Predecessor Fund, the Fund has assumed the Predecessor Fund's historical performance. Therefore, the performance information prior to August 25, 2023 is that of the Predecessor Fund, which had a different fee structure from the Fund. The returns of the Predecessor Fund have not been adjusted to reflect the applicable expenses of the Fund. **2. The S&P 500<sup>®</sup> Index** is widely regarded as the standard index for measuring large-cap U.S. stock market performance. Index results assume the reinvestment of all capital gain and dividend distributions. An investment cannot be made directly into an index. The S&P 500<sup>®</sup> Index is generally representative of the market sectors or types of investments in which the Fund invests. **3. Standard deviation** measures how widely dispersed a fund's returns have been over a specified period of time. A high standard deviation indicates that the range is wide, implying greater potential for volatility. **Alpha** measures a fund's risk-adjusted performance and is expressed as an annualized percentage. **Beta** is a measure of historical volatility relative to an appropriate index (benchmark) based on its investment objective. A beta greater than 1.00 indicates volatility greater than the benchmark's. **R-Squared** measures the percentage of a fund's movements that result from movements in the index. The **Sharpe Ratio** shown is calculated for the past 36-month period by dividing annualized excess returns by annualized standard deviation. The **Annual Turnover Rate** measures how quickly securities in the Fund are either bought or sold during the 12 months as of the most recent annual shareholder report.
